1. We agreed that we were enjoying the longer gathering, and how it makes going to somewhere farther away more feasible and worthwhile. This was discussed further in the next meeting.

2. The question of how we work with different issues such as working on a site without being given direct consent, i.e. asked by someone other than the owner to do some work. It was agreed that this is rather a grey area, as good work may well spread out from a site we do have permission for, or impact on others. It was agreed that generally speaking we can only send love without direct permission, especially to a human, [as opposed to a property.] The practise of simply expecting to sort somewhere out - example was a group who thought they could "sort out" Glastonbury!!! - was felt to be wrong, though sending Love in the hope of supporting the locals seems OK.

3. It seems that some dowsers feel very uneasy about the word Magic, and do not want it to be connected with dowsing or geomancy. This group seems to agree that we actually work magic, and do not feel it is a black or evil process.

4. This did not get much talk time, though it was strongly supported by some of the group when mentioned as an idea.
